We offer a secondary curriculum that closely mirrors mainstream education but is delivered in small, nurturing classes and specialist staff. Student's Social, Emotional and Mental Health needs are supported by our Personal Development curriculum based on the Executive Functioning skills. All students are able to practice the application of these skills in weekly enrichment opportunities as part of our curriculum offer.
