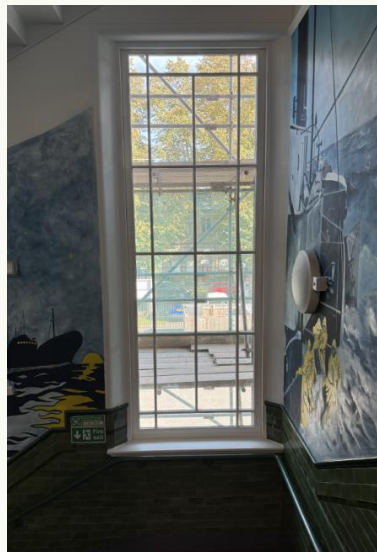
Venn Boulevard Centre Newsletter

Reminder of New Arrival Arrangements

Pupils made a fantastic start to the term following our new arrival arrangements, our phone storage is safe and secure and nearly 100% of pupils are wearing uniform.



1. All pupils enter school in the morning through the café door.

2. Pupils hand in mobile phones and any personal belongings which will be kept until the end of the day. Mobile phones will be kept in individual, named storage boxes. Vapes will be destroyed if not collected by parent/carers.

3. Pupils then pass through the scanner.



4. Uniform will then be visually checked and any pupil not wearing uniform will be asked to change into loan uniform for the day.

5. Pupils will then be collected by their tutor. Any pupils who do not follow our expectations will not be able to join their class and parent/carers will be called to support.
